Attendance: Attendance at all rehearsals and events is mandatory for every member. Any absence or tardy must be communicated to Mr. Meckes PRIOR to the day of absence. Excessive absences or tardiness may result in removal from the group and loss of points from your grade (even class failure).

Please understand that *any absence for any reason* has a negative effect on the team. Our group's success is based on your commitment to improve and perform your skills with the team at every session. Excellence in performance is our team's goal – not winning! If you are not at practice, then your spot will be filled by an alternate.

- * We will use alternates. They are determined by the color guard staff. All alternates will be given notice of their status. Alternates are members of the Warren Central guard and will be held to the same standards as the full-time members (attendance, equipment / body skills, fees, grades, etc.). Alternates will not perform competitively.

Note: Full-Time and Alternate Positions are NOT necessarily permanent. A full-time member CAN lose their spot. Alternates that keep up their grades, work ethic, and attitude, can potentially obtain a full-time position.

- * Practice clothing is required at all rehearsals: (No Jeans or anything baggy will be allowed. Please wear comfortable clothes that you can move and dance in.)
- * We will work hard during **every** rehearsal. **Bring a container of water to keep you hydrated.** Never expect water to be provided for you!
- * Any **infraction of the rules** established by the Warren Central Color Guard or the Warren Central High School Student Handbook may result in immediate dismissal from the Warren Central Color Guard (without any fee refunds). ALL SCHOOL RULES APPLY.
- * **PARENTS:** All rehearsals will be **closed until the last 15 minutes** of each session. This policy is for the students' safety and to ensure that their highest level of focus is applied during every rehearsal. Special open rehearsals will be announced for parents, friends, and supporters. We encourage all to attend those open sessions.

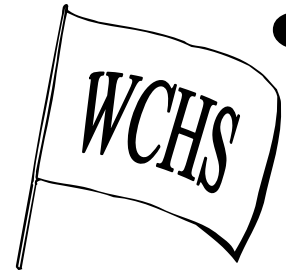

WC Gold Brigade 2010 Commitment Form and Contract

Each member of the Gold Brigade Color Guard must pay **\$350 Gold Brigade Guard Support Fee**. Many bands in the Indianapolis area have a \$500-\$1500 marching band fee, so ours is modest in comparison. Your Support Fee goes towards uniform, competition, travel, and meal expenses. Additionally, fees go toward the uniform fund, trailer maintenance, instructional assistants, and other areas vital to fielding a marching band.

There are set deadlines for fee payments:

<u>Payment:</u>	<u>Deadline</u>
#1: \$150	July 15, 2010
#2: \$100	August 15, 2010
#3: \$100	September 15, 2010



Full payment or remaining balance may be paid prior to any deadline.

EARLY BIRD SPECIAL 10% DISCOUNT
FEEES PAID IN FULL BY THE FIRST PAYMENT DUE DATE OF JULY 15TH
WILL GET A 10% DISCOUNT

REFUNDS for Drop-Outs:

Each member is responsible for the membership fees that were due by the date they quit. Excess amounts will be refunded when a participant's parent gives written notice to a director and is based on the amount the member has paid at the time of withdrawal.

Example: If a participant has paid \$350, and elects to dropout on August 1st, the remaining \$200 would be refundable. There are no refunds after September 15th.

The Parent/Guardian accepts full responsibility in giving permission for the Student to travel and participate with the Warren Central Color Guard in all activities during the 2010 season. Activities include, but are not limited to rehearsals, performances, and team building events. Permission will NOT be granted to any student wishing to drive to or from competitions.

The Parent/Guardian agrees to pay the \$350 membership fee and all required fees as scheduled so the Student will be allowed to participate in the 2010 Color Guard program. The Parent/Guardian agrees that failure to pay the total fee for the Student will result in actions to be taken by Warren Central High School or the WCHS Band Boosters to collect said fees. The Parent/Guardian will be held responsible for any additional costs (i.e. collection agency and court costs) incurred for any actions taken to collect this debt.

REFUNDS & MEMBERSHIP WITHDRAWAL: The Parent/Guardian accepts financial responsibility for the Membership Fee as outlined in the payment schedule. A Student that withdraws from the program is financially responsible for the payments that were due at the date-of-withdrawal. For example, if the Student or Parent/Guardian notifies the director that the Student will withdrawal from the group on August 21, then they are responsible for BOTH the July and August payments (not September) totaling \$250.
